

This email confirms that the radar cameras (just as the gatehouse cameras) will be connected to the Fusus platform and made available to the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office (SJSO) **on a voluntary, request- basis only**.

Key points for clarification:

- The camera connection to Fusus is **voluntary**.
- SJSO **does not have 24/7 live access** to the camera without permission.
- Access is **only granted when requested** by SJSO and approved by the controlled access chair and FCS, typically in response to a specific incident.
- The system **does not provide automatic or continuous monitoring** by law enforcement.
- The camera is **not linked to any federal or nationwide surveillance network**.
- Any sharing of video is **limited, incident-based, and locally controlled**.

The purpose of connecting to Fusus is to enable **faster information sharing during emergencies**, while maintaining full control and privacy for the camera owner and residents.
