The following is what to expect and what is included in our quote to repair Install 8 ft gooseneck pole at Player's Park at Sawgrass TPC Ponte Vedra Beach, FL 32082

We will mobilize material, equipment and personnel for every aspect of the project.

Install Goose Neck Basketball Pole

- * Dig out a 18x18x48 hole
 - * Form hole to pour concrete
 - * Put steel in hole to strengthen concrete
 - * Mix and pour concrete
 - * Set pole to 8ft height
 - * 4 ft overhang
 - * Install 2 ft foul line only (not full key or 3pt line)
- Note: (No backboard included customer will order and install later)

½ deposit to put on schedule with balance upon completion



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Terms & Conditions:

All pickleball or basketball equipment installed will have factory warranty available. Installation will be warranted for two year not to include damaged equipment from vandalism or use not according to manufacturer standards.

The owner will provide access to the court, water, and electricity. Also, the owner must have items removed from surface area or moved as necessary. Additional charges may apply if not completed and must be made by our staff.

We will do our best to limit or mitigate any damage to Landscaping and sod due to entry and exit of court construction however any damage will be the responsibility of the customer.

The estimated time to complete your project is 2-3 day prep and 7 days new surface install. However, the project may take longer due to poor weather conditions or things out of our immediate control.

While core drilling or digging to install net post sleeves and basketball bases, Pickled Court will not be responsible for any damage to pipes, electrical or any other utilities that may be disrupted by such installation of post and sleeves.

The court owner resumes all responsibility for the prolonged routine upkeep and maintenance of the basketball pole, unless otherwise stated in a separate maintenance agreement.
